There are eight award categories:

There will be one winner in each of the categories. Winners will receive a Memorial Tanoa with Plaque & name recognition on photos that may be chosen for usage on the Save the Children Fiji Christmas Card Collection 2007.

A prize will also be awarded to the Most Outstanding Adult Photographer & the Most Outstanding Budding Young Photographer

- All entries must be supplied as a **20 x 25 cm (8 x 10 inch) print**
- All prints are to be clearly marked with the entrant’s name, title of the work and other details requested
- Prints submitted must be original. Photocopied reproductions or any other representation of the work will not be accepted
- Entry fee is \$13 for young people up to the age of 18 and \$23 for adults. This payment can include entry of up to 4 photographs
- All prints entered must be accompanied by a written piece no more than 50 words long explaining what inspired the Entrant to take the photo and a CD containing jpg of images entered

Save the Children Fiji - National Photography Competition

Theme:

Photographers are invited to submit images taken within Fiji in response to the theme '**CHILDREN - THE WAY TO UNITY**'.

Award categories:

The competition is open to amateur, professional and young photographers (children up to the age of 18). The photography competition has eight entry categories: *Brightest Smiles; Funny Faces; Playtime; Mischievous Looks; It's A Small World; Age Of Innocence; Portrait; Peace & Hope.*

An award each will also be given to the *Most Outstanding Adult Photographer* and the *Most Outstanding Budding Young Photographer*.

Please ensure you have read the conditions of entry. Entries will be accepted on the assumption that the conditions are understood and accepted.

Conditions of entry:

- All entries must be supplied as a 20 x 25 cm (8 x 10 inch) print
- Each entrant is permitted to enter a *maximum* of 4 photographs (digital form and /or manual form, black & white or colour)
- Each photograph must be accompanied by a title and approximately 50 words describing the photograph and the moment in which it was taken.
- Each entry must reflect the theme of 'Children – the way to unity'.
- The subject matter of the photographs submitted must be from within Fiji.
- Prints submitted must be original. Photocopied reproductions or any other representation of the work will not be accepted.
- The photograph must be taken by the person whose name appears on the registration form
- Photographs that have been digitally manipulated or altered will not be accepted.
- The competition is open to citizens of Fiji or residents for at least twelve months.
- You must ensure that permission has been given by any person photographed for the image to be entered in this competition.
- No photos of naked children will be accepted
- All reasonable care will be taken to safeguard the photographs while in the custody of Save the Children. Save the Children is not responsible for damage to, or loss of, any entry.
- All entries received will remain the property of Save the Children Fiji.
- **All entries are to be sent in a padded envelope accompanied with a CD of digital images of each sent image/entry.**
- Each entry sent in must have label provided glued on back of print with photo details

Payment

All entries must be sent in a padded envelope purchased from Post Fiji. Entries can be either sent through Post Fiji's **FreePost Service** stating the Save the Children Fiji Photography Competition FreePost number: **02/07** or hand delivered to the Save the Children Fiji office, Suva. An example of how your entries should be packed for postage and addressed can be found below.

All entries must be accompanied by money payment of \$13 (for children up to the age of 18) or \$23 for adults. Any entry not accompanied by payment of entry fee will not be eligible for consideration by the selection panel. There will be no refund of entry fee for any reason.

Payments can be made through Post Fiji's **BillPay Service** at any Post Office nationwide or at the Save the Children Fiji office, 25 Pender Street, Suva.

Closing date

All entries must be received by close of business Friday 21st September 2007. Late entries will not be accepted.

Prizes

There will be one winner in each category. Winners will receive a Memorial Tanoa with Plaque along with name recognition on your photo if used in the Save the Children Fiji Christmas Card Collection 2007. No alternative, cash or otherwise, will be given for any prizes.

Winners will be notified by phone or by e-mail. The results will be published on the Save the Children website at www.savethechildren.org.fj

- b) the photographs you submit shall not infringe the rights of any third parties

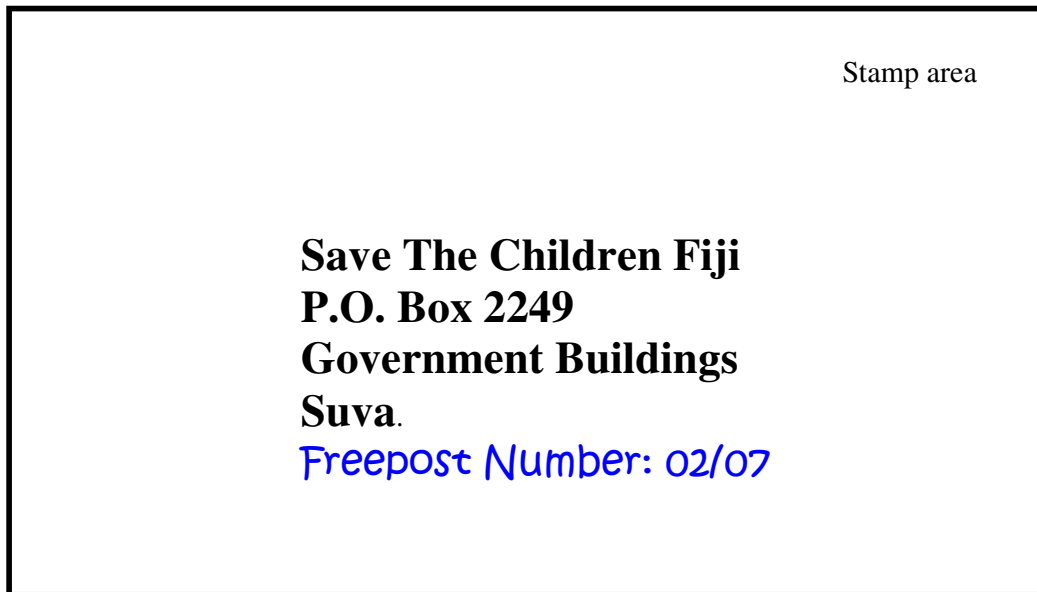
All copyright and title to all entered photographs will be with Save the Children Fiji and you grant Save the Children the right to use the photographs for any
